
Home Learning Nursery

Activity – Pop up cards



Resources

- ~ Card- different colours (paper can work too)
- ~ Scissors
- ~ Glue
- ~ Pens

Optional extras:

- ~ Glitter
- ~ Googly eyes








Method

- 1. Take one piece of card
- 2. Fold in half
- 3. Make two cuts in the centre of the card (fold side) to make a tab
- 4. Open the Card and push the tab out
- 5. Cut out your pop out image
- 6. Attach image to tab

Optional:

Have a go at making different types of pop up cards, like the rainbow card pictured above.



We have found that the children love this activity. Not only is it great fun, this will help your child develop their fine motor skills, hand-eye co-ordination and creative skills.

Encourage your child to be as independent as possible, supporting with holding the scissors correctly and if necessary cutting.

How to get your child thinking?

- 1. Can you show me how to make a pop up card? (Encourage your child to lead the activity)
- 2. What equipment do we need?
- 3. Can you show me how you should hold your scissors?
- 4. Where do we cut to make the tab?
- 5. What will be popping out of the card?
- 6. How will we stick the pop up picture to the tab?
