Treasure map making

Recourses

- A plain piece of paper
- A used damp teabag
- Pens/pencils



Method

1. Take a blank sheet of paper and a damp teabag rub the teabag over the paper until stained brown.
2. Gently crumple the paper and set to one side until dry.
3. Once dry unfold and tear along the edges to make the paper look old.
4. Using your pens/ pencils draw on your treasure map you could draw rooms in the house a map of the garden etc.
5. Don't forget to mark where your treasure is hidden with an X.
6. You could also use some printed images such as treasure chests and gold coins and ask your child to cut and stick them onto the map.

How to get your child thinking

- Have a look at a room in your house or garden, what things can we put onto our treasure map?
- How can we represent this table or chairs on our map?
- I wonder where we could hide the treasure? We can put an 'x' to mark the spot.
