
The school receives additional funding which allows us to provide:

- One-off credit of £100 towards uniform, trips or music lessons

Who is entitled?


YOU MAY BE ENTITLED IF YOU ARE IN RECEIPT OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

- **Income support**
- **Job seekers allowance**
- Employment and **support allowance**
- Support under part six of the **Immigration and Asylum Act 1999**
- the Guarantee element of **State Pension Credit**
- **Child Tax Credit** - providing you are NOT entitled to Working Tax Credit and your family's annual income (as assessed by HMRC) is not more than £16,190 (as at 6 April 2012)
- **Working Tax Credit** 'run-on' - the payment you may receive for a further four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
